This funding will be used to


- Increase A-B level results on report cards in English from 50% 55%.
- Increase the percentage of students reading at or above their age appropriate level.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving 'A-C' in English from 90.3% to 95%.

Our initiatives include

- Empowering staff to deliver effective strategies for the teaching of reading and writing.
- Provide facilitated planning and data analysis for teachers (once per term).
- Fortnightly meetings working on the CASW moderation project.
- Teachers being involved in learning tours of other classrooms in other schools to develop their practice and pedagogy.
- Support case management of vulnerable students through case management partnerships.
- Invest in aligning strategies across the school to develop a whole school approach to writing.
- Provide professional development, coaching and access to view best practices, to ensure staff development of their understanding and deconstruction of the Australian Curriculum.
- Increase teacher aide time to facilitate learning based on reading and writing programs.
- Professional development for all staff for the effective implementation of reading and writing.
- Supporting inclusive education funding Teacher Aide in class support of SWD students for targeted intervention.
